Our home is a few miles from the city of Exeter and also features on the main bus routes, making it easily accessible.

We have a large communal lounge where our residents can relax, meet family and friends, enjoy a chat or watch their favourite television programme. The Conservatory is a favourite room and we also use this for activities. In both of our dining rooms, we have restaurant-style dining offering nutritious food and we are happy to cater for individual tastes. At Exmouth House, we have a clear understanding of the importance of preparing residents' favourite foods with a view to encouraging healthy appetites. This helps to ensure our residents eat and drink enough to ensure a healthy diet in a social and convivial atmosphere.

Residential Care

With individual care focusing on being a home from home experience in delightful surroundings, we aim to encourage our residents to remain as independent as possible with support from our team. Whether you have mobility concerns or require care and support with everyday tasks, or maybe feeling lonely and isolated living at home, Exmouth House offers a high standing of living in a caring environment that promotes good health and overall well-being.

Dementia Care

We work with dementia care experts, concentrating on creating purposeful and meaningful activities to keep life interesting and fun at Exmouth House. Our care is as individual as each of our residents and they set the routines with support from our caring team. We encourage our residents to socialise with each other, as research shows that people who are regularly engaged in social interaction maintain their brain vitality. We utilise all of the modern techniques to support our care.

End of Life Care

Exmouth House has accreditation with the Gold Standards Framework (GSF) Care Homes Programme. This means our home offers the highest standards of care to people at the end of their life. We work proactively with local GPs, primary care teams and specialists to provide seamless care to residents in their last months, weeks and days.

Respite Care

Caring for an elderly or disabled family member can be extremely rewarding – yet at times, both physically and emotionally challenging. Our respite care service is ideal for those needing a short break either to recharge their batteries or to make necessary adaptations at home.

Day Care

If a brief change of scenery is required then our friendly day care service is a great solution for both you and your loved one. As a carer, daily errands may be easier to complete with a day of respite as well as any necessary adaptations to the home.

Person Centred Care


