Mick has come up with some suggestions of things to add, listed below. If you can help with any items then please drop them into us here to add to the board.

Update on developments within the home

- We held Resident and Relative meetings on Friday 27th September at 11am and Monday 1st October at 6.30pm that all were invited to attend.
- We currently have no lift as you all may be aware, this is going to be replaced but will take some time for a new lift to be built, we thank you all for your patience and apologise for any inconvenience caused. If you are struggling with using the stairs, please do not hesitate to use the chair lifts.
 - Paul has started to paint the hallway downstairs and I hope you agree this is already starting to look great.
- Decorating plan – we still continue to decorate bedrooms and we are slowly making our way around. There have also been some changes to the reception area which now looks more inviting. We plan to move into the dining room and complete the first-floor corridor in the near future.
- We are adapting the dining room so that we can have a space where the residents can (if they choose to) do more meaningful activities. This will involve a work surface and a sink area.

We still wish to develop the garden and front of the home. At the recent residents and relatives meeting a relative suggested that it may be nice for relatives and friends who struggle with things to buy individuals, that they may like to 'sponsor' a plant for the garden which will also help to keep the garden well stocked and looking nice. Anyone who may wish to do this please speak to a member of the team and your loved ones can see them grow and help to nurture them.

- Staff room – the team have been taking breaks in the dining room as you will have seen as they did not have a dedicated staff room, this is now being changed. As the hairdressers has moved to the community centre we are adapting the hairdressers into a staff room. (This has been postponed due to the lift being out of action) A staff room has been made temporarily on 3rd floor whilst the lift is out of action.

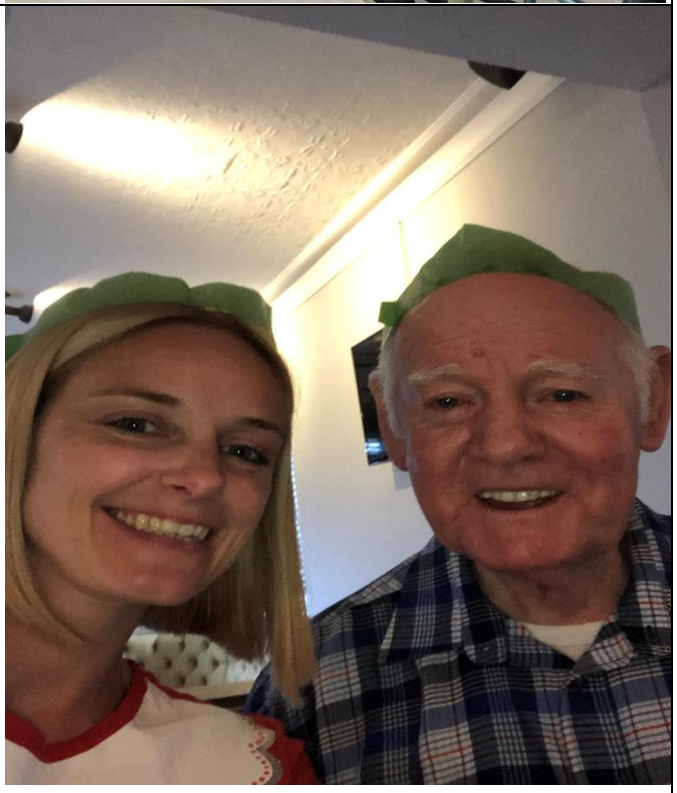

Following the rebrand, we will be sending out the Photo consent forms to update. Please can we ask that you complete and return them to us for our records.

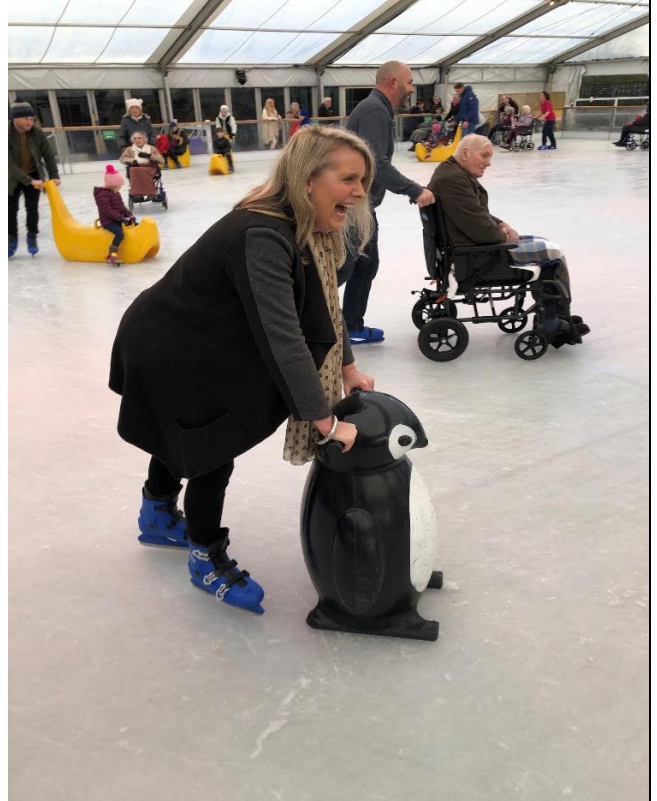
We have had some lovely trips and entertainment over the last month which have brought a lot of fun and happiness for those who have taken part.
