You have probably heard that people over 75 will have to start to pay for their TV license. However, if you are in receipt of Pension Credit you may still be entitled to a free license. If you are unsure if this applies to you, give me a shout and I'll try and point you in the right direction for some help.

From the Age UK website: 'It only takes one phone call and you won't have to fill in a form. Call the Pension Credit claim line on **0800 99 1234** (textphone: 0800 169 0133). They will fill in the application for you over the phone. It'll be quicker if you have the following details to hand:

- National Insurance number
- Bank account details
- Information about your income, savings and investments
- Information about your pension (if you have one)
- Details of any housing costs (such as mortgage, interest payments, service charges)
- Partner's details (if you have a partner)
